Meetings are held Wednesday mornings at 10am and Thursday evenings at 7pm

PENNDOT has begun their 2-year improvement project on Plank Road and its intersections with RT 73 and RT 29, in addition to construction on Ott Road and Myers Road. This means that PLANK ROAD will be CLOSED TO THROUGH TRAFFIC starting April 1st 2017, through the end of the year. The Old Mill House and the day use area of Central Perkiomen Valley Park across the street WILL STILL BE ACCESSIBLE. The ONLY access point will be from RT 29. Visitors will NOT be able to access Plank Road from RT 73. You will have to go beyond the construction barriers to enter the Old Mill House parking lot.
